Hartford On List Of 'America's Drunkest Cities'

Hartford ranks 68th on a [list of America's Drunkest Cities](#) compiled by [MensHealth.com](#).

The report weighed 100 U.S. cities by the following: death rates from **liver** disease, admissions to binge drinking, arrests for driving under the influence, deaths in DUI-related crashes and severity of DUI laws.

Hartford's DUI laws were ranked among the most lenient, trailing only Newark, N.J., Jersey City, N.J. and Sioux Falls, S.D. on the list.

Fresno, Calif. led the list because of its high ranks in liver disease-related deaths and DUI arrests. Boston was deemed the most sober city in the list due to low death rates from liver disease and DUI crashes.

The report cites data from the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#), the [Fatality Analysis Reporting System](#), the [FBI](#) and the [Insurance Institute for Highway Safety](#).
